

VILLAGE OF GLEN CARBON LIQUOR LICENSE APPLICATION

To the applicant:

All applications for the renewal of a license shall be made in writing to the local liquor control commissioner at least thirty (30) days prior to December 31st of each year. Each renewal license shall terminate on the first day of January.

Please remember to complete the affidavit, without the signed affidavit your application will not be accepted.

The Illinois Liquor Control Act, 235 ILCS 5/1-1 et seq. and Ordinance No. 2000-27 of the Village of Glen Carbon, require that no person shall sell, keep or offer for sale at retail, or conduct any place for the sale at retail of, alcoholic liquor within the corporate limits and territory of the Village of Glen Carbon without having a license to do so issued by the local liquor control commissioner of the Village and a valid license for the purpose issued by the Illinois Liquor Control Commission. In order to receive a license from the local commissioner, this application must be completed in full and submitted with the appropriate fee. Submittal of an application and fee does not guarantee that a license will be issued.

Please follow the directions for the completion of the application.

Section I - General Information

This section to be completed by all applicants

A. Please indicate the type of license being applied for: CLASS: _____

CLASS A: entitles the licensee to sell alcoholic liquor at retail for consumption either; a. on the premises or;
b. off the premises where sold in the original package.

Requires an annual fee of six hundred twenty five dollars (\$625.00).

CLASS B: entitles the licensee to sell alcoholic liquor in the original package only, for consumption off the premises.

Requires an annual fee of six hundred twenty five dollars (\$625.00).

CLASS C: entitles the licensee to sell alcoholic liquor, at retail for consumption on the premises by the general public or a private party, in conjunction with hall or room rentals where a charge is made there directly or indirectly through an admission fee, service charge, meal charge, donation or any other charge whatsoever. A Class C license can only be issued to a licensee that already holds a Class A, D, E or F license.

Requires an annual fee of six hundred twenty-five dollars (\$625.00).

CLASS D: entitles the licensee to sell alcoholic liquor, as part of a restaurant business, for consumption on the premises only.

Requires an annual fee of six hundred twenty five dollars (\$625.00).

CLASS E: entitles the licensee to sell beer and wine only as part of a restaurant business, for consumption on the premises only.

Requires an annual fee of four hundred seventy five dollars (\$475.00).

CLASS F: entitles the licensee to sell alcoholic liquor, at retail by the drink or Pitcher, for consumption on the premises, or off the premises where Sold in the original package, by clubs as they are defined in the Village of Glen Carbon liquor control ordinance.

Requires an annual fee of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00).

CLASS G: entitles the licensee to sell alcoholic liquor at retail for consumption on the premises by the general public or a private party, in conjunction with a hall or room rentals where a charge is made therefore either directly or indirectly through an admission fee, service charge, meal charge, donation or any other charge whatsoever. Under no circumstances shall a Class G license be issued to a for profit entity.

Requires an annual fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00)

CLASS H: entitles the licensee to sell alcoholic liquor at retail in an outdoor area of the licensed premises. Outdoor Dining and/or Drinking Area shall mean a designated area on the premises of a retail food establishment, restaurant or tavern, but outside the principal building, where patrons may consume food or beverages ordered from and served by a waiter or waitress or by purchasing at a dedicated location (bar) from a bartender. The outdoor area where alcoholic liquor shall be permitted to be sold, served or consumed on the premises of the licensee shall be specifically defined in this application and may not include any portion of the premises also used for driveway or parking purposes. Use of the area defined in this application must not present any safety issues or dangers to patrons or the public as determined by the building and fire codes adopted by the Village or of the respective fire district serving the premises. A Class H license can only be issued to a licensee that already holds a Class A, D, E, F or G license and shall be limited to the outdoor area that is part of the same licensed premises.

Requires an annual fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00)

**SPECIAL EVENT USE PERMIT: 3-2-19
AMENDING ORDINANCE 2010-14**

Liquor License Holders: Any person, corporation, or association who holds a valid license to sell at retail alcoholic liquors, issued by the Illinois liquor control commission, a permit authorizing the person to sell alcoholic liquor, at a particular place or premises to be described in the permit, in conjunction with a special event, for a period to be specified on the permit and not to exceed four (4) days per calendar year. A permit fee of forty dollars (\$40.00) per day.

Non-liquor License Holders: Special events permit may be issued to the following non license holders: Village of Glen Carbon, a not-for-profit corporation, religious organization, charitable organization. Fees for non-license holder special events permits shall be ten dollars (\$10.00) per day, and such events shall not exceed five (5) days per year.

B. Please list the location and description of the premises or place of business, which is to be operated under the license. (Note a separate application must be submitted for each address).

I. Please provide Certificate of Liquor Liability Insurance of Dramshop Insurance coverage including the name and address of insurance company for both the licensee and owner of the building in which alcoholic liquor will be sold for the duration of the license.

Section II - Individual Applicants

This section to be completed if the licensee applicant is an individual.

- A. Please provide the name, address, telephone number and the date of birth of applicant.

- B. Please provide the citizenship of the individual and the place of birth. If a naturalized citizen, provide the date and location of naturalization.

- C. Please list any criminal arrests including the crime, location, date of arrest, arresting agency and disposition.
